WHAT IS THE MURPHY CENTER?

The Murphy Center (MC) is a “one-stop-shop” resource center in Larimer County for people who are homeless or near-homeless. The MC serves three roles: (1) facilitate collaboration among 17 independent agencies that, together, provide a continuum of support to people who face homelessness (2) provide basic core services (e.g. mail) and (3) host morning/day shelter. Our goals are to empower people to meet their immediate and long-term needs *and* further our community’s plan to make homelessness rare, short-lived and non-recurring.

WHAT IS THE MISSION TO HOPE WALK?

The Mission to Hope Walk is a one-of-a-kind event, bringing together people who are housed and people who are homeless to raise awareness about the MC, its partners and homelessness. The 0.8-mile walk represents a journey that many of our guests (clients) take every day to get to and from the shelters and access services.

WHY SPONSOR?

Your sponsorship will help facilitate more than 35,000 guest visits to the MC this year and will provide individuals like Roshon the opportunity to overcome barriers to self-sufficiency:
